- B) Brief Background of Club (i.e. number of members and leaders, types of projects traditionally taken in club, number of years club has been active, etc.)
- C) A description of the agriculture awareness project (include objectives and goals of the project)
- D) Date and place of the project (if applicable)
- E) Club or District Involvement in Project Planning and Implementation (i.e. number of members that participated in project planning and implementation, what the roles and responsibilities were of members and leaders to make the project a success)
- F) Increased Knowledge of Awareness to the club and/or community from the project
- G) Benefits to the club or District from carrying out the project (i.e skills developed, experiences gained, etc.)
- H) Pictures of the event (if any)
- I) Any publicity or press coverage (press clippings) of the event (if applicable)
