Rules

2. Possession or use of alcoholic beverages and/or non-prescription drugs is not permitted: If found, authorities will be contacted, parents/guardians will be informed and participants will be sent home at their own expense.

Participants are asked not to smoke during the 4-H program.

4. No participant may leave the program site without the permission of a staff member. This will be strictly adhered to.
5. Vandalism of any form will not be tolerated. Any damage costs will be charged to the member and his/her parents.
6. Indecent language of any form will not be tolerated.
7. All participants must complete a health information form and this conduct form.

Those who do not adhere to the rules may forfeit the privileges of the program and their parents will be called to come and take them home.
